BUILDING & GROUNDS ACTIONS

Paul & Susan Bergmann and Mike Reavis joined this part of the meeting representing the Building & Grounds Committee.

Paul and Susan presented 3 options for new carpeting for the Fellowship Hall stairs. The Board unanimously approved the option to glue down carpet around the stairlift supports (\$3371). Most of the cost is covered by insurance money from the roof water dam.

Dave M presented 4 options for sanctuary lighting improvements. The Board unanimously approved the nondimmable LEDs option for both the sanctuary pendants (\$1512) and the wall washers (\$672). The wall washers will be installed first to verify lighting levels, and then the next step will be confirmed with the Board.
